AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made the 1st__ day of __November, 2021_ by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, hereinafter called "County" and the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, hereinafter called "City".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, County is desirous of participating in projects and the provision of services mutually advantageous to the County and other units of government;

WHEREAS, City is improving multiple bridge decks at Mohawk Park Golf Course, and City represents that the bridges are pall of the City street system;

WHEREAS, the golfcourse is in Tulsa County. The golfcourse is a revenue generating enterprise within the Cotmty, hereinafter called "Property";

WHEREAS, the County has the skillset and trained labor force to perform said repairs, hereinafter called "Improvements";

WHEREAS, pursuant to 69 O.S. 1903, County and City may contract with each other to construct, improve, repair or maintain any of the other. No party to the contract shall be liable for the acts or omissions of the other parties or for failme to inspect or supervise the performance of the other party.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and conditions hereinafter contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The City agrees to purchase all required materials for the Improvements on the Propelty.
- 2 The County agrees to install the Improvements to minimize adverse impact on the use of the Property. Once the Improvements are complete, the Property will be restored by the City.
- 3. The County will perform the Improvements at a time that does not conflict with the County construction and inspection activities.
- 4. Neither party hereto without the express written consent of the other shall assign the rights, duties and obligations under or arising from this Agreement.
- 5. Neither party shall be liable for the acts or omissions of the other patty or for failure to inspect or supervise the performance of the other party.
