INCIDENT RESPONSE RETAINER

When an incident occurs, it is the responsibility of the Client to contact Alias by phone at 405-261-9517. Once communication is made, Alias will immediately start the Incident Response engagement. During the initial contact, the Client must provide Alias with as much detail as possible about the incident. The Client must further supply log data, with the assistance of Alias, to immediately begin the Incident Response investigation. Only personnel authorized by the Client are allowed to spend hours being retained by Alias.

If Alias is unable to obtain the correct data required to fulfill the investigation remotely, an Alias Incident Responder will be dispatched to the Client's on-site location for collection and assistance. Once the correct data is obtained, Alias will conduct the investigation and provide a deep analysis report (if requested by the Client) with an executive summary, detailing the entire investigation, assessment findings, remediation recommendations, and any other relevant details to the incident.

Applicable Incidents

Information security incidents which fall under the retainer agreement include but are not limited to: Website Defacement, Distributed Denial of Services (DDoS), Man in the Middle (MITM) attacks, Code Injection, Malware, Malvertising, Phishing/Whaling attacks, Ransomware, Virus and Worm Outbreaks, Rogue Software, Insider Threat Investigations, Drive-by Downloading, Wireless Access Point Compromise, Brute Force Attacks and other instances where data may have been exfiltrated, unlawfully accessed, or its integrity has been compromised.



CLIENT ACCOUNTABILITIES

The Client is accountable for providing access to all devices and systems that require forensic preservation. The Client must have the legal right to the designated computer system(s). Any travel expenses including hotel, mileage or per diem must be covered by the Client (if necessary) and agreed upon in writing by both parties. Should the Client choose to engage with Alias to address an incident, billing will begin at \$750 per hour for 30 hours, with additional time billed in 20-hour increments at the same rate. Alias recognizes the client as a OneNet customer and will be discounted by 12%, bringing the cost to \$660 per hour for 30 hours, with additional time billed in 20-hour increments at the same rate.

Extensions will be billable in 20-Hour Increments, approved in writing in advance of continued services. Billing is at the rate posted above for all extended hours. Forensic storage and expert witness services are billed separately.



CONTRACT

AGREEMENT SUMMARY

This agreement is made as of the 4/29/2024, by and between: The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, the Client in this agreement, and Alias Forensics Inc., located in Oklahoma. Both parties have agreed upon payment terms as listed on the previous page to be paid in full before services are performed.

Regarding the Security Services, both parties hereby acknowledge and agree:

- 1. That Alias Forensics Inc. will perform the selected security services as outlined in the associated proposal.
- 2. That Alias Forensics Inc. will provide all proper documentation of findings throughout the engagement. Further, any accumulated data from the engagement will be provided to the Client and is not the responsibility of Alias Forensics Inc. to maintain copies of such records within our facility.
- 3. That the Client is responsible for all managerial decisions and functions related to the service, for designating an appropriate individual to oversee the engagement, and for proper remediation of the findings provided.
- 4. That the Client is granting full authorization to Alias Forensics Inc., regarding the targeted range or listing of IPs and associated computing environment for the entirety of this contract as necessary to fulfill the requirements of the engagement.
- 5. That the Client has the sole responsibility for adequate protection, backup of data or equipment used, and will not make a claim against Alias Forensics Inc. for lost data, re-run time, inaccurate output, work delays, or lost profits resulting from the services.



- 6. That Alias Forensics Inc. will not divulge any information about the Client's organization or internal environment it receives because of the engagement; all information is confidential and will be treated as such.
- 7. That if the retainer must be exhausted on an Incident Response engagement requiring more than the initial 30-hours, any additional service hours required beyond the retainer must be approved in writing, after which they will be billed to the client at the agreed upon discounted hourly rate above. (This does NOT include service hours for Expert Witness testimony)
- 8. This agreement shall be termed to coincide with The Clients fiscal year, through June 30th, and shall automatically terminate thereafter unless extended in writing by both parties under a new contract agreement.
- Both parties hereby acknowledge and agree to the terms and conditions set forth in Alias Forensics Inc.' executed Master Service Agreement, Contract No. C2403, made by and between Alias Forensics Inc. and OneNet on Nov 13th, 2023.
