CANDIDATE FILING BEGINS FOR MUNICIPAL OFFICES

Candidates interested in filing for municipal office in 4 Tulsa County municipalities will file Declarations of Candidacy beginning 8 a.m. Monday, December 4.

Gwen Freeman, Secretary of the Tulsa County Election Board, said Declaration of Candidacy forms must be completed and submitted to the County Election Board no later than 5 p.m. Wednesday, December 6 when the filing period ends. Freeman reminds voters that Contests of Candidacy must be filed no later than Friday, December 8 and may only be filed by another candidate for that office, unless a candidate files unopposed.
