Roads and Bridges

Bridge Replacement Completed!

Doyle Nix, longtime South Tulsa County resident, was the first driver to cross the new bridge when it opened on 171st Street, between Elwood & Hwy 75. Thank you for being patient during this project.

Bridge Repaving

Repaving continues on 5 small bridges on a 1.3 mile stretch of 171st St. between 145th E. Ave & 161st E. Ave. (Old Hwy 64).

Snake Creek Bridge Replacement

The 201st St. S Bridge over Snake Creek has been closed while replacement plans were being made. Construction started this week with site clearing. Snake Creek Bridge is a truss bridge built in 1909. It is 125 ft long, and 14 feet wide and was Functionally Obsolete and Structurally Deficient, prior to its closure. This \$2.13 Million project is estimated to be complete in January of 2025.

Garnett and 101st Expansion

The project will widen Garnett Rd. from 2 lanes to 4 lanes, from 101st St S to the OTA overpass, and to 5 lanes from the overpass to the 91st St S Intersection. The project is being funded by 4 to Fix II (~1.7M) and a Hazard Mitigation Grant (~8.1M), for an overall project cost of ~9.8M. The project will take approximately 10-12 months, and will be bid as soon as the regulatory approvals are completed. We hope to be cleared to bid the project late in 2024 for a spring 2025 construction start. Expect to start seeing some progress very soon!

Economic Development

Economic Development is booming in Tulsa County! Over 10 years ago, Commissioner Dunkerley was on the frontline to help bring Simon Premium Outlets to Jenks. On August 15th, he was front and center with other speakers such as Governor Kevin Stitt, State Representative Lonnie Sims, Muscogee Nation Chief David Hill, and Simon Mall Officials for their Grand Opening.

The new Reasor's in Broken Arrow opened August 8. There are also several new restaurants and shopping venues coming to the South Aspen Ave./Creek Turnpike Area.

The new Scheel's store at Woodland Hills Mall is set to open this October and it's going to be a shopping and recreation destination! Once opened, Tulsa Scheels will employee over 500 workers and house 75 specialty shops within 240,000 square feet of retail space housing over a million products from hunting gear to home decor, and everything in between.

Bixby is also poised for growth with the new hotel and conference center, shopping and office space going in at "Spartan Square."

The groundbreaking for the new Senator James M. Inhofe Air Traffic Control Tower at the Tulsa International Airport took place on August 1. The new tower will be 100 feet taller than the current 70year-old structure, greatly increasing the square footage available for commercial business expansion on TIA grounds.
